## CHECKLIST FOR MEMBERS REGISTERING HISTORIC VEHICLES ON CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

The following information is designed to assist FCNSW members register their vehicle under the NSW Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS).

1. **For new vehicles to the scheme**, complete the Application for Conditional Registration (RMS form 1246), and ensure that the AIS (pink slip) provider completes and signs the "vehicle identified by" section on page 3. Also answer at Q8 = Car, Q9 = NSW.
2. Complete and sign the FCNSW Member Declaration and Vehicle Eligibility form and send it to the Historic Plates Registrar (HPR) to file with the club's HVS records.
3. Arrange for your vehicle to be inspected for age and originality by the HPR, or provide photos.
4. **For new and renewing registrations**, complete two copies of the Historic Vehicle Declaration (RMS HVD form 1259). Include any recognised secondary car clubs where you are a financial member. Both copies will be stamped and signed by the HPR, the original will be returned to you to take to the RMS, the second copy will be retained by the HPR. Forms can be posted (to address below), scanned (as a .pdf), or taken to a club meeting.
5. Please ensure you are, and remain a financial member of the FCNSW, and any secondary clubs. This is an ongoing condition of your registration.
6. Obtain a Safety Inspection Report (or pink slip) from an inspection station prior to registration becoming due. You need a manual pink slip for HVS registrations.

Please do not post original pink slip or registration documents to the HPR, if they go astray in the post they will need to be replaced.

7. Once you have the HVD form signed and stamped you can go to the RMS for the renewal of an existing registration, or the issue of a new historic registration and plates. The RMS will issue you with an individually numbered 60 day personal use log book.

Please note that the HVS is a privilege extended to the classic car movement, and that the operation of the system is under regular review by the RMS and the CMC.

FCNSW members taking part in the scheme are reminded to comply with the spirit of the scheme at all times, to ensure it remains available to all members into the future.
